

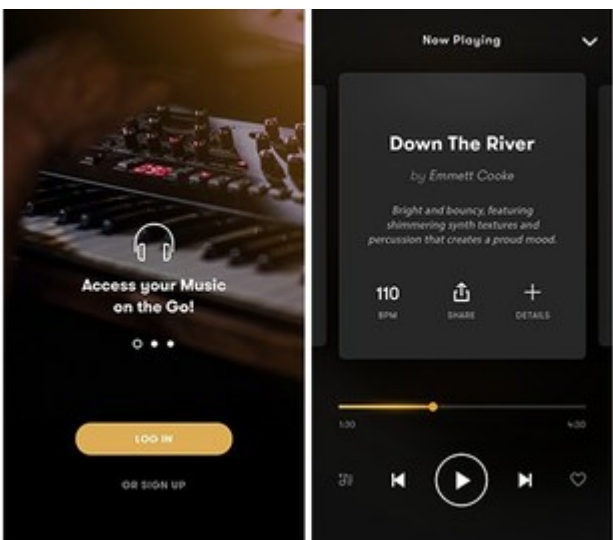


PremiumBeat Launches Mobile Application for Music Discovery On-the-Go
